

Entry Fee - \$250 per boat (2 man team).

\$125 extra for additional angler. (Maximum number of anglers per boat is 3)

Boat numbers will be determined by paid boat entry.

All contestants must check in at registration the morning of the tournament starting at 4:00 a.m. **All boats must be checked before launching.** Entries will be allowed the morning of the tournament payable in CASH ONLY. The official tournament waters are all bodies of water reachable from the launch point without removing boat from the water or having to ford natural or manmade banks. Air Boats are prohibited. Safe boating must be observed at all times. Each competitor is required to WEAR a Coast Guard approved flotation life vest securely fastened whenever the combustion engine is running.

All competitors are expected to show courtesy to all persons on the water. Drunkenness will not be tolerated. Boat captains are not permitted to drink any alcoholic beverage or other stimulant during the tournament. No competitor shall have a non-competitor "sit on a hole", or spot, or scout for them. Each competitor agrees by signing this application form to submit to a polygraph examination if requested by tournament officials. All protests must be filed in writing and signed by the competitor making the protest within 15 minutes after weigh-in to the judges. All decisions by the judges will be final. All bass must be taken in a sporting manner. Only artificial baits may be used. Trolling is prohibited. Fly rods may not be used. Each boat must have a functional kill switch. Boats must have an operating live well, or some type of live well system, coolers with air pumps are permitted. A total of 5 largemouth bass per boat may be weighed in. 14 inch size limit will be enforced using the Golden Rule flat board. Any team presenting more than 5 fish to the tournament staff will be culled down to 5 fish, starting with the largest fish first. DEAD FISH will be penalized at the rate of 4 oz. per dead fish. Short fish will be automatic disqualification. Any fish that appears to be mangled, mashed or altered in any way will be disallowed. Big Fish will be determined by the total weight of one single bass. No Dead Fish Will Be Eligible For Big Fish Pot. All boats must check in by appointed time or a one pound per minute late penalty will be subtracted from the total score. Fifteen minutes late is total disqualification. There will be no weigh in before 3:00 p.m.

NO FISHING IN BASIN. NO CULLING IN BASIN OR AT THE DOCKS.

In case of a boat or motor failure, one team member may be brought in on another tournament teams member's boat, with both team's fish being separated at all times. Interpretation of these rules shall be left exclusively to the tournament officials. Decisions of the officials are FINAL. Infraction of these rules is grounds for disqualification from this and future tournaments.
